Look for These Signs of Fraud on Your Credit Report

You've heard about the importance of that doesn't belong to you, it is a strong

indication of fraud.

You've heard about the importance of checking your credit report at least once a year, but do you know what to look for? Here are some tips to help you spot errors that could be warning signs of fraud:

Take a Good Look

Look for accounts you never opened. This could indicate that your information has been mixed with someone else or that someone has obtained credit using your identity.

Look for credit inquiries that you don't recognize. Your credit report will list the names of companies that have obtained your credit information in the last two years. Those labeled "promotional" inquiries are from preapproved credit offers. Those labeled "account review" inquiries are from current lenders reviewing your credit. Check all other inquiries to make sure you recognize what they are for, but keep in mind that sometimes the name that appears on the credit report will not match the name of the place you applied for credit. (For example, you may apply for credit at a furniture store, but the credit would be handled by a finance company).
